Delivery of boats.

All the boats that will sail in the regatta should arrive at the Corinthian Yacht Club guest dock on Saturday, September 17th, between 9 am and 1pm. Boats cannot arrive on Friday or Sunday, the harbor is going to be closed for a swimming race from Angel Island into the CYC Harbor. As you approach the harbor, please call the dock master of the CYC: Hans at 415.302-5083, for instructions on where to tie up. Our boats will be inside the breakwater, on row closest to the breakwater, and next to the clubhouse. If you anticipate any difficulty in bringing your boat over, please let us know. When you arrive, please be sure to tie up your boat using the dock space as economically as possible. Raft up to other Folkboats if it will make it easier for the next boat to arrive, and so on. Everyone knows what it's like to sail into a dock without room to land.

To Owners Loaning Boats.

- Foreign skippers have all responded that they will bring their own sails. The Corinthian Yacht Club has no storage space. Therefore, please take your sails and other non-essential gear away with you during the regatta. Examples of things to remove include: outboard motors, fuel tanks, cooking utensils, and personal clothing. Please ensure that the boat has the required equipment listed below, which the foreign skipper will acknowledge responsibility for. Also, if your boat is equipped with a tool box, it would be a very nice gesture to leave it on board.

- Foreign sails will all require jib-sheeting on the cabin top. If your boat does not yet have cabin-top jib sheeting, please notify us ASAP so we can help you properly install it.

- We will provide bottom diving services if your boat requires it, so please tell us in advance so we can order it to be done at CYC. As a courtesy, we would appreciate your bottom being cleaned shortly prior to delivery.

- The drawing for boats is on Sunday at 1300. We invite you to be recognized when your boat is drawn, and later go over your boat with the foreign skipper who has drawn it. During the regatta, a member of the local fleet will be assigned to your boat to ensure it is returned to you in the condition it was received.

- Your boat and the foreign skipper will be covered for both collision damage and \$1,000,000 liability, under US Sailing's "borrowed boat" coverage.
